

USSA Alpine Masters 2014 Phillips 66 Western Regional Championships Regional Champions Team (Men)

The USSA Alpine Masters Regional Champions team is selected from the competitors in each class with the greatest total of World Cup points from their finishes in all of the three events of the championship. The 2014 Western Region Championships were hosted by Intermountain division at Park City, UT on Feb. 6-9, 2014, as part of the FIS Masters Cup event.

Eligibility note: Competitors must be licensed USSA masters competitors from a western region division to be eligible for the overall regional class champion award.

In M09 (65-69), Eastern division racer Pepi Neubauer was first overall with 100 points – although eastern region racers are not ordinarily eligible for the western region champion award, with no eastern regionals in 2014 a joint award was made in M09 to Neubauer and to top western region finish Tom Kronthaler. In M13, Canadian racer Larry Tomie was tied with Gaet DeMattei (FW) but is not eligible for the western regional champion award.

There was one tie in the overall combined standings for regional champion in the Group A men's classes at the 2014 Western Region Championships. Bryant Davis (IM) and Joe Lindsay (IM) are tied at 25 points; both finished 1 race and were first in their class, so still tied after applying the best-finish-record and lowest-race-points tiebreaker criteria.

Tiebreaker Notes

Ties between competitors are decided by best result (best result, then next best, until broken; if finish records are equal in all races then race points are used as an additional tiebreaker criteria).

M02 (30-34) – tie between Bryant Davis (IM) and Joe Lindsay (IM) at 25 points.
