M10 – tie on 65 points between combined winner George Dorris (IM, 3-2-1-2) and Randy Fout (RM, 2-x-2-1). National team selection goes to George Dorris based on the best-finish tiebreaker criteria (1-2-2-3 over 1-2-2-DNF)

M08 – tie on 65 points between Jesse Scroggins (PN, 2-1-2-x) and combined winner Willy Scroggins (PN, 1-x-3-1). National team selection goes to Willy Scroggins based on the best-finish tiebreaker criteria (1-1-3-DNF over 1-2-2-DNF)

W07 – tie on 70 points between combined winner Heather Black (IM, 1-2-1-2) and Anna Nystrom (PN, 2-1-x-1). National team selection goes to Heather Black based on the best-finish tiebreaker criteria (1-1-2-2 over 1-1-2-DNF)
